## Lao President Bounnhang Vorachit meets with Li Jiheng

On May 5, the Lao delegation headed by Bounnhang Vorachit, General Secretary of the Central Committee of the Lao People's Revolutionary Party and Lao President, met in Kunming with Li Jiheng, Secretary of the Yunnan Provincial CPC Committee.

Yunnan hopes that both sides can further their person-toperson exchanges, deepen friendly contacts and consolidate friendship by deepening pragmatic cooperation, advancing interconnectivity and facilitating the development of the Mohan-Boten Cross-Border Economic Cooperation Zone. Moreover, both sides wish to give fuller play to the role of Yunnan-North Laos Cooperation Mechanism in promoting trade and cooperation in tourism, agriculture, energy, transportation, education, technology and health. Li invited Bounnhang to attend the 4th China-South Asia Expo and the 24th Kunming Import and Export Fair in Kunning later this year. During the visit, the Lao

delegation also met with other Chinese leaders and signed cooperation documents with Chinese counterparts, laying a solid foundation for cooperation between Laos and China, in particular Yunnan. The Lao side believes that with the improvement of transport infrastructure, as well as further exchanges and cooperation between Laos and Yunnan will be further expanded and upgraded. Laos will give full support to facilitate bilateral cooperation projects for common development. Laos is willing to actively participate in exhibition events hosted by Yunnan, such as China-South Asia Expo and Kunming Fair.

## 21,300 university students in Yunnan long to be expo volunteers

On May 4, 240 Kunming local volunteers gathered at the Guandu Square to welcome the 4th expo.

Since recruitment of volunteer for the 4th China-South Asia Expo was launched on March 4, more than 21,300 university students from 25 higher institutions in Yunnan have submitted their applications, according to personnel with Yunnan Provincial Youth League Committee.

2,500 volunteers will be selected out of the applicants to serve the 4th expo to be held in Kunming on June 12-17, and the selection is based on their performance in the following training sessions which include etiquette, physical strength, and language proficiency.

In 2015, around 1900 volunteers from various walks of life served the 3rd expo.
