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Energy cooperaion becomes the new economic drive In B&R region

The May in 2017, the first Belt and Road International Cooperation Summit Forum was held in Beijing. The results of the Form covered five major topics such as policy communication, facility links and removal of trade blocks with more than 270 specific achievements, many related to the energy industry. Chinese government departments issued Promote the Vision and Action of the Belt and Road Energy Cooperation and other documents to boost cooperation in the field of energy.

Energy infrastructure development is imbalanced in the Belt and Road area. According to the IEA's forecast, by 2040 the annual new installed capacity in the Belt and Road area will exceed 80 million Kilowatts and will be the world's fastest growing region for electricity. In the Belt and Road Initiative, energy interconnection is an important area and an important bridge connecting Asia and Europe.

Since the Belt and Road Initiative was implemented, China' import of oil from countries along the Belt and Road has hit a record high, accounting for 65% of total oil imports. It is China's

main source of oil imports. At the same time, China continues to expand the export market of its refined oil products. In 2016, its exports of refined oil amounted to 19.3 billion U.S dollars, about 70% to the Belt and Road countries

From many oil and gas projects invested in the Belt and Road countries, Chinese enterprises have formed a set of exploration and development, pipeline construction and operation, engineering and technical services, refining and sales of oil and gas industry chain cooperation pattern.

The development of the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor has been remarkable, becoming the flagship project of the Belt and Road Initiative. Under the Corridor framework, the number of projects under construction and completed reached 20, with a total investment of about 18.7 billion U.S dollars.

Salvador Heresi Chicoma, general secretary of Peruvians for Change, said the CPC's newly elected leadership has significance not only for Chinese people, but also the world because the CPC is offering solutions on many global issues."It is very important for people in South America to have a book about the experience of the political administration here in China. because it is a model whose characteristics are innovation and openness," he said.

The book, covering 17 topics, collects 99 of Xi's speeches, conversations, instructions and letters between 2014 and 2017. The first volume was published in September 2014 and received widespread attention and praise from readers at home and abroad. Kyle Warwick Tomlinson Cultivate tropical biology talents

"I am a macro ecologist and I want to know how the world's vegetation is distributed. South Yunnan is a tropical forest with a savanna, and diversity in the middle. I like working in Yunnan," said Dr. Tomlinson, who comes from Ireland.

Dr. Tomlinson had worked for many years at the internationally renowned Wageningen University of the Netherlands and currently is a leader, researcher and doctoral tutor of a research group on the Ecology and Conservation of Tropical Botanical Garden Communities in Xishuangbanna, Chinese Academy of Sciences, mainly engaged in the study of natural and man-made ecological disturbances. In 2014, he was selected to the Chinese Academy of Science

Foreign Youth Program. In 2013, Tomlinson formed an international research team of 23 young scholars from 10 countries and has chaired a national fund – Yunnan provincial joint fund project a national fund project to study the effects of savanna ecology, plant functional diversity and configuration, plant physical defense and forest fragmentation in Yunnan and Southeast Asia. His research work has greatly deepened the understanding of savanna

and its diversity in arid

and hot valley areas.

He has overseen 17 doctoral and postgraduate students. Many times he has organized trainings for the Tropical Biology and Conservation Association and its branch in the Asia-Pacific region, has been an organizer and expert for the Chinese Academy of Sciences "Advanced Ecology and Conservation Biology Field Training".

For the Lancang-Mekong Cooperation, Chinese enterprises have made great contributions to the infrastructure construction in the five Mekong countries. As of October this year, Chinese companies' had signed contracts for infrastructure projects in the five countries valued at 137.99 billion U.S dollars.

Yunnan and Laos to strengthen rapid customs clearance

Today, china's vegetable brand construction has been beginning to show results, such as the Yunnan vegetables we see today, once unknown vegetable products, now it is well-known by more consumers by

establishing various brands. The brands also enriched millions of farmers.

Through continuous optimization adjustment, Yunnan vegetable production areas gradually concentrated with a more and more reasonable layout, realizing the significant change in the scale development from sporadic production to concentrated advantage producing areas. Now, there are 457 enterprises engaged in vegetable production and processing, of which 126 are provincial-level leading agricultural enterprises with

10 kilometers away from the Kunming South High-Speed Railway Station, Asia's largest market for fresh cut flowers – Kunming Chenggong District Dounan Flower Market is bustling.

bustling.

"This year, our flower sales have increased by at least 30%." Mr. Zhou, who has been selling carnations for more than 10 years, believes that the operation of high-speed trains has injected new impetus into the Dounan Flower Market. More and more tourists make Dounan Flower Market the last stop of their trip to Yunnan.

By the end of 2016, the Shanghai-Kunming high-speed railway and Yunnan-Guangxi railway Kunming section opened to traffic and Yunnan entered a high-speed rail era. By the end of November 2017, within less than one year, Kunming South Station has seen about 6.45 million passengers and 6.55 million passengers leaving and arriving, respectively.

High-Speed rail not only benefits the Dounan Flower Market. The construction of high-speed rail and inter-city network rely on Kunming South station. Mushroom collectors in Chongxiong, Yuxi and other cities sell mushrooms to different places in China via high-speed rail trains.

Since the opening of the

high-speed railway, travel time from Yunnan to Beijing, Shanghai and Guangzhou have been shortened by more than two-thirds, driving a vigorous growth in Yunnan's tourism economy. Puzhehei, a scenic spot in Wenshan Zhuang and Miao Autonomous Prefecture Qiubei County of Yunnan Province stepped directly into the high-speed rail era from having previously had no railway at all. According to Qiubei County Government's statistics, Puzhehei received 1.717 million visitors in the first half of 2017 with an overall income of nearly 1.2 billion yuan, which increased 23.3% and 46.3% respectively compared with the same period

last year.

Since the Shang-hai-Kunming high-speed rail and Yunnan-Guangxi railway opened to traffic, China Railway Kunming Bureau Group Co. Ltd. has increased trains to Beijing, Shanghai, Guangzhou and other cities to meet market demand. Currently 65.5 round trips run daily.

Yunnan is committed to building a comprehensive transport system connecting South and Southeast Asia, in future it will be transformed from a National transportation network "peripheral" into a "hub portal" for China to connect with South and Southeast Asia.

kilometers per hour on the Beijing-Shanghai high-speed rail, China has become the world's fastest high-speed rail business.

The car has a full
