28 Thai students study high-speed rail technology

On March 8, the requirements. Guangxi Liuzhou Railway Vocational and Technical College held the opening ceremony for the first batch of 28 Thai international students. These Thai students came to study China's highspeed rail technology.

With the continuous deepening of cooperation between China and Thailand in the high-speed rail field, the Liuzhou Railway Vocational and Technical College connected with many Thai universities in order to resolve problem of lack of talent for local railways in Thailand.

Zhou Lan, Director of Academic Affairs Department of Liuzhou Railway Vocational and Technical College, stated that in 2015, they signed an inter-school cooperation agreement with the Thai Ayutthaya Institute of Business and Technology determining that the "1+1.5" cooperation method should be used to train international students. After studying in Thailand for one year and having qualified and obtained corresponding Chinese language level certificates, Thai students can come to China to study for one and a half years as long as they meet the visa

"After all the studies in China and Thailand are completed, qualifying students will receive diplomas from universities in both China and Thailand. This project is welcomed by students in Thailand," said Zhou Lan.

The 28 international students will study high speed rail related majors, mainly including railway signal automation, railway engineering technology and so on.

20-year-old Sutama came from Sachaburi, Thailand. She just arrived at the Liuzhou Railway Vocational and Technical College to study and was very excited. She said that in the future, China-Thailand railway cooperation will become more in-depth and the Thai railway industry has a promising future. She wanted to study hard here and bring the related technology of high-speed rail development in China back to Thailand.

So far, the school has set up five "training classes for vocational teachers in rail transportation", and trained more than 70 Thai teachers. The cooperation between the college and Thailand in the field of rail transit is continuing to deepen

Yunnan precious culture connects with Asia



China-made large aircraft C919 takes orders to 815



China-produced large passenger plane C919 was successfully launched in May, 2017 (Xinhua)

Wu Guanghui, chief designer of the Chinese-made C919, told reporters that 815 orders from 28 domestic and foreign purchasers have been received. In the future, more C929 will also be produced.

For the first aircraft, according to Wu Guanghui, water ballast has been used to simulate the impact of passengers seated in different positions on the aircraft's forward and aft sections in attempts to test load capacity. The plane's airspeed will also be tested, and stalling umbrellas will be fitted to the aircraft for the somewhat dangerous "Our application for an

EASA Certificate of Airworthiness has been accepted, and we've made two airworthiness certification flights," he said. Wu Guanghui added that the large aircraft has also delivered an encouraging performance in terms of management and market. The company is being jointly reviewed by the Civil Aviation Administration of China and by European airworthiness authorities to ensure that the aircraft is in the best and safest state possible, he said

Young man leads villagers to better life

From a migrant worker to the outstanding manager of a Hong Kong company, and then to the deputy of the National People's Congress, Yuan Haibo, a young man from Yunnan born in

1991, is still learning and exploring. When the reporter met him in the residence site for the "two sessions" deputies, he was discussing with other delegates on how to follow the road to prosperity for his hometown.

Yuan Haibo was born in the hilly valley of Ciying Town, Qujing City, Yunnan Province. To the east is Fuyuan County, the most impoverished county in Yunnan Province. The agricultural population of the town accounts for almost 99% of the total population.

The main industries in Cizhen are tobacco, vegetables, and silkworms. At present, a vegetable base for the Hong Kong region has been completed, and a highland characteristic agricultural industrial park is under construction. However, the silkworm industry has just begun.

'Several neighboring villages near my hometown are sericultural farmers. Af-

ter they raise the silkworm, they sell the silkworm cocoons." Haibo was excited, "If we process the silkworm cocoon into rough finished products and then sell it, there will undoubtedly be higher profits for the villag-

Haibo told the reporter that he had a "magnificent" idea: to set up a cooperative and invite the villagers in neighboring villages to join in so that he can lead them out of poverty to pursue a better life. Haibo said that there

are 88 impoverished counties in Yunnan. There are many places like Ciying Town in Yunnan. In addition to the policies and financial support provided by the government, if the villagers can get out of the mountains, see the outside world and return to their hometowns, their ideas will surely change, and this will affect and change their style of life and production.

This idea is closely related to Yuan Haibo's experience. After graduating from high school in 2010, in order to ease the family's burden, Haibo packed his bag and went to Yiwu, the International Trade City in Zhejiang Province and got a job there as an international export salesman for a lock

Because of the nature of his job, he had to deal with foreigners every day. Haibo began to learn English on the Internet and could speak English fluently after practicing. At that time, Haibo was just 20 years old. He realized to get rich himself was not true riches, and he should help the folks in his hometown. After the Spring Festival in 2012, Haibo took a group of 7 friends and relatives to Yiwu and helped them find jobs.

In 2012, Haibo resigned from Yiwu Trade City to work for Boni Clothing Co. Ltd., a Hong Kong company in Suxizhen. Due to his hard work and constant study, good communication skills and excellent interpersonal relationships, Haibo was promoted to workshop team leader half
